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Clinical Edit Criteria Logic

1. Is the claim for ≥ 150 mg per day?
 Yes (No PA Required)
 No (Go to #2)

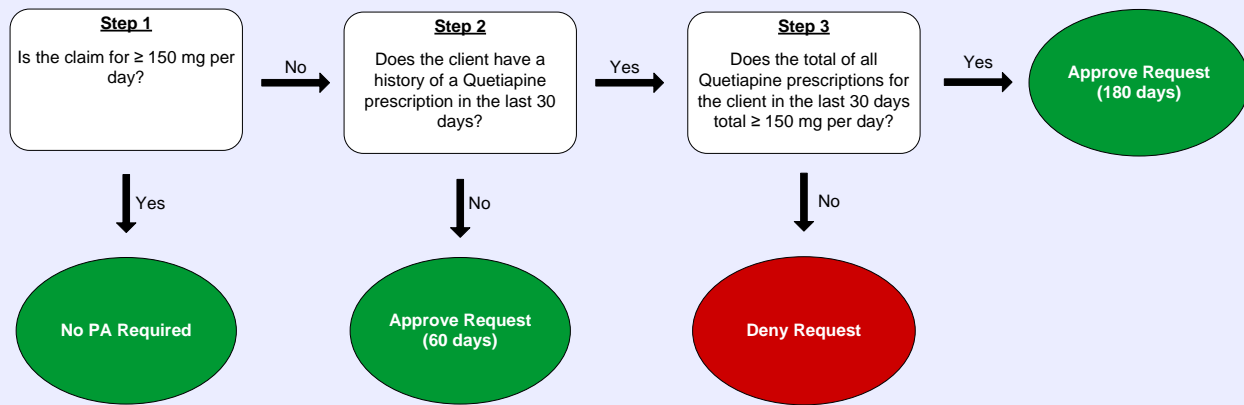
2. Does the client have a history of a Quetiapine prescription in the last 30 days?
 Yes (Go to #3)
 No (Approve – 60 days)

3. Does the total of all Quetiapine prescriptions for the client in the last 30 days total ≥ 150 mg per day?
 Yes (Approve – 180 days)
 No (Deny)
